



Social Host Law

REDUCE UNDERAGE DRINKING

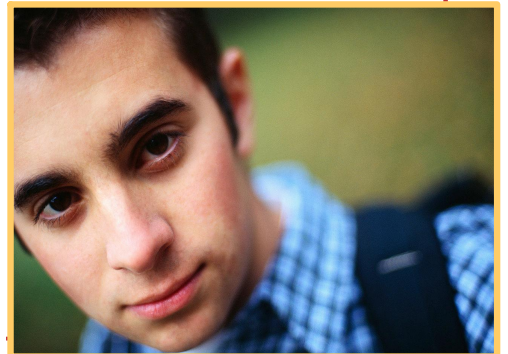
A **Social Host** is a person who permits a party where one or more minors under the age of 21 are consuming alcoholic beverages.

If you are hosting a party you are required to:

- Control access to alcohol.
- Control quantity of alcohol.
- Verify age of guests.
- Supervise minors.

Underage drinking is illegal and can lead to death, unintentional injuries, vehicle crashes, homicide and suicide.

The Social Host Law makes hosts liable and prevents underage drinking parties.



Violations can occur:

- Charged with a misdemeanor;
- Fined up to \$1,000;
- Face up to 6 months of jail and;
- Pay recovered costs of law enforcements and emergency services.
